## **Step by Step Guide**

#### I. Make Contact

Compile a list of friends, colleagues and family members to invite. Send an invitation email as soon as possible. Follow-up with a second email or a phone call a week later. Don't wait -- Start today!

## 2. Communicate Effectively

This is a fundraising event. There is no ticket price, nor is there a minimum donation.

### 3. Tables of 10

Each table accommodates 10 guests plus a student and a teacher. Oversubscribe your table! Due to unforeseen circumstances, guests may drop-out last minute. If you have more than 9 confirmed guests, we will accommodate them.

## 4. We'll Help Fill Seats

Contact us if you come short of 10 committed names. Please let us know as soon as possible.

## 5. Submit your Guest List and register your guests.

Guest lists are due Thursday, October 1. Please register yourself and your guests on the Gonzaga Prep website. You can email any changes or additions to Wendy Griffin by October 8. Please double-check spelling for name tags.

### **6. Pre-Luncheon Reminders**

We will send an email reminder to all guests by October 7. In addition, please contact all of your guests a few days before the event. Tell your friends you're excited for the event by posting messages on Facebook, twitter, etc.

## 7. Day of the Luncheon

Doors open at 11:00 am. All guests are encouraged to come early. There will be opportunities to talk with friends and with Gonzaga students, faculty and staff to learn more about what's happening at Gonzaga Prep before sitting down. The official program will begin promptly at 12:00 and wrap up by 1:00.
